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Risk Likelihood and Severity Definitions

Likelihood	Severity
<p>High 3</p> <p>Likely to occur in the short term</p>	<p>High 3</p> <p>Risk capable of resulting in death, disability or serious illness with career-threatening outcomes, has major damage or loss of capability</p>
<p>Medium 2</p> <p>Might occur in time Defining by exclusion, clearly not high or low Maybe the most practical approach</p>	<p>Medium 2</p> <p>Hazard capable of resulting in moderate personal injury or illness or damage and loss of capability</p> <p>It may be more practical to define the term medium by exclusion, being not obviously High or Low severity to the individual or club</p>
<p>Low 1</p> <p>May occur in time, however low expectation of occurrence</p>	<p>Low 1</p> <p>Hazard resulting in minor injury requiring first aid Minor lost time only or slight damage Minor loss event to the individual or club</p>

By relating the values achieved by the severity and likelihood assessment to a simple matrix as shown, a notional value of risk severity can be obtained. The higher the value the greater the requirement for implementing risk reduction controls.
